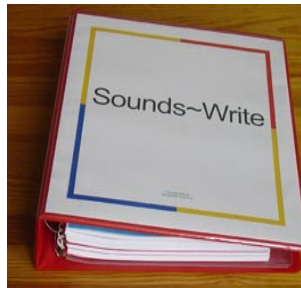

Notice for KS1 parents—ParentPay accounts.

You may have noticed your account has £2.40 showing as a payment to be made. Unfortunately there is a glitch in the system, which ParentPay are unable to remove.



We understand that this may be confusing to KS1 parents. The £2.40 payment showing, is the cost of a school meal. As KS1 children do not pay for a school meal, there is no relevance for this amount to be quoted. We have asked ParentPay to remove it, but sadly, their system will not allow this.

Children in Darling Class do not pay for meal, therefore there is no need for you to click on the £2.40 payment or make a payment.

On occasions, parents and siblings may stay for a school meal. When this happens we will calculate the amount owing and collect this separately.
