

## EYFS Home Learning Mat

Reception children to complete at least 1 activity from this mat.

*The children will have the opportunity to share their learning on the 14<sup>th</sup> February, however children may bring anything to school that they have completed at any time. We shall keep it safe to be shared at the end of term. Enjoy!*

Visit a bakery with a grown-up.  
Make a note of all the different types of bread available.  
Present your findings, including:

- a drawing
- with help from an adult, use your sounds to label the type of bread

Find a recipe from the internet or a recipe book to make pizza dough.  
Collect the ingredients you need. This might involve using your sounds to have a go at writing a shopping list and collecting ingredients from the supermarket with a grown-up.  
Follow the recipe to make your own pizza dough and enjoy!  
Don't forget to take a photograph of your finished product.

Rainbow writing

Practice writing your name every day for 20 days. Use a different colour every day (you might run out of colours and have to use the same one more than once!). Remember to use your letter writing mat from your book bag to form your letters correctly.



Make a poster by drawing different hazards that we must be very careful with in and around our home.
