

Stanton St Quintin Preschool

We are very excited to be opening a preschool at Stanton St Quintin in September 2020. The preschool will form part of a Foundation Unit that will include Foundation 1 (Nursery) and Foundation 2 (Reception).

Motivate, Educate, Nurture

Specialist teacher's will motivate, educate and nurture using a balance of activities, tailored to a child's interests to meet their individual learning needs.

Independent Learners

Children will be provided with choices within the environment (both real and imaginary), so that they become confident in making decisions.

Children will be supported and encouraged to become independent in their personal development and to develop positive relationships with their peers.

Play – based Learning

Children learn best through play and this will be at the heart of learning at Stanton St Quintin.

A fun environment will provide children with a wide range of learning experiences and opportunities so that every area of development receives attention.

Learning in our stimulating and purposeful environment will encourage children to take risks with their learning, become creative thinkers and foster independence.





Staff

The Foundation Unit at Stanton St Quintin is staffed by specialist teachers with a full-time teaching assistant.

We all have a passion for teaching the early years and believe that providing children with creative and challenging opportunities will instill in them joy and a love of learning.

We are facilitators to your child's learning and will seek out opportunities to join in with play to create meaningful learning experiences that address each individual's next steps.

Snacks and Lunches

Healthy snacks will be provided for children. There will be a small charge of 50p for a snack

If children are staying with us all day or joining us for the afternoon session, they will be having lunch with us. This can be a healthy packed lunch brought from home or a hot school dinner.

These are prepared daily, on site by our catering contractors and are quite delicious!

Parents and Carers


Building a strong and positive relationship with each child's parents and carers is extremely important to us. We believe that great communication is a two-way process that has a positive impact on the well-being of each child. So if there is ever any concern or query you have, please do tell us. We are a close team and the information will be passed on.

Uniform

Children attending Nursery should wear a blue school jumper, with the school logo, with a white t-shirt and blue/black joggers.

Shoes should be waterproof and practical – no lace-ups.

Much of our learning will take place outdoors, so a pair of wellies that they can keep at school and waterproof trousers and coat (ideally a ski-suit for warmth for the winter months).





Entitlement

All 3 and 4 year olds are entitled to up to 15 hours of free education each week from the start of the term *after* their 3rd birthday. Some children will be entitled to 30 hours funding.

Session Times and Prices

Our Pre-School is open from 9am to 3pm for children aged 3 to 5 years old. Children can stay all day or for a morning or afternoon session.

Morning Session, 9am to 12pm

Afternoon session, 12pm to 3pm. The afternoon session will include lunch as part of the session.

Additional hours are charged at £6 per hour.

We can provide wraparound care from 8am to 5:30 if required.
