Next week we will be holding a non uniform day to raise funds for FOSS which in turn raises funds for our children.

Sport and physical activity continues to be an integral and important part of our school curriculum. Stanton are part of the Chippenham Sports Partnership and in 'normal years' we would have been taking part in inter school tournaments and festivals. In the 'new norm' the partnership are offering school based sessions, where specialist PE teachers will work with the children and teachers to develop their PE skills. Mrs Porter from Sheldon School will be visiting new Friday to work with children in their class bubbles. We will off course be following strict COVID protocols and afPE (Association for Physcial Education) guidance.

In the afternoon, normal Lacrosse, and Daily Mile will take place for our Y1-6 children. But all children, we hope, will be able to take part in a yoga session too, led by our very own Mrs Morley. You may remember Mrs Morley use to teach yoga during our Enrichment Afternoons last year.


Woof! A message from Beau
