## Amazon Class- The Egg Theatre Trip Monday 12<sup>th</sup> December 2022, 2pm

Dear Parents/Carers,

During Term 2, we shall be visiting The Egg Theatre in Bath to watch '5 Children and It'; a fantastic performance based on the original story by E.Nesbit. We shall be using this experience to inspire our story telling and performing.

We shall be travelling to the theatre by coach, leaving school after lunch at 1pm to ensure we arrive promptly for the 2pm showing. Lunches should therefore be ordered in the normal way and shall be eaten at school as normal.

We shall be arriving back at school at around 5pm and ask that everyone collects their child from school at this time. This time shall be confirmed nearer the time.

Please ensure your child brings a named coat and a named water bottle to school as we shall be taking the water bottle carriers with us to the theatre.

The cost of this trip for theatre tickets and coach travel is £21.30, to be paid via ParentPay, which shall also act as permission for your child to attend this offsite trip. Please can we ask that this is **paid by Thursday** 13<sup>th</sup> October as tickets are currently reserved and have to be finalised by the end of term. Should you have any difficulties covering the cost of this trip, please contact the school office.

We are able to cover our child:adult ratios with school staff, however we do have a further 6 theatre tickets and coach spaces available which we are offering to parents on a first come first served basis at the same cost of £21.30 per person. Filling these spaces, will help keep the cost down.
